

Future Tense

There are two main ways of describing actions which are to take place in the future:

The Immediate Future is expressed as in English, by taking the present tense of 'ir' + a + the infinitive

Eg – voy a hablar con tus padres

The Simple Future – where the endings are added to the infinitive:

hablaré	comeré	viviré
hablarás	comerás	vivirás
hablará	comerá	vivirá
hablaremos	comeremos	viviremos
hablaréis	comeréis	viviréis
hablarán	comerán	vivirán

There are some irregular items, however they all end in ‘-r’, and the endings are the same as for regular verbs. Thus the irregularity is in the stem, never in the endings. Here are some of the main irregular verbs:

cabr	ponr	decir
